

## the contents of my family Bible (FHL) and its Annex

For my own family rendering of the Bible, which I refer to as FATHER’S Holy Light (FHL), I chose to organise the books differently than any Bible I have ever seen. As a head of household, it is my right and duty to do so if required for the proper training of my own children. Using *order-of-precedence*, “FATHER’s Words First”, the authoritative books were set into logical groups with all else in an Annex.

A few portions show up twice (for example, some Songs of Moses and King David) but I have not removed anything from the 66 books. I sought and found a practical outcome – improved clarity for teaching.
